

ATHENS FESTIVAL 1979

Every summer, at the foot of the venerable rock of the Acropolis and against the background of the golden, mellowed Parthenon in an environment where the dim past blends dramatically with the present, thousands of greeks and foreign visitors, sitting on the marble tiers of the Herod Atticus Odeon, enjoy theatre, opera, music, ballet and modern dance performances presented by the Athens Festival. The Odeon was built in 161 A.D., by Herod Atticus, in memory of his wife. Regilla, in the style of Roman theaters of the period, which its stage raised to a height of 1.10 meters. The stage wall, three storeys high, was decorated with columns in the Corinthian style and rounded or square niches for statues, while the auditorium was propably surrounded by a large, semi-circular arcade. The roof was of cedar wood... Athens Festival presentations began twenty-five years ago and have received international recognition. The Festival performances form the most important artistic summer event in Athens and it aims for the highest artistic ideals by linking the ancient heritage and the modern, with European tradition.
